

## **College/University Entrance Exams**

For those students wishing to take entrance exams (i.e., SAT's, ACT, TOEFL, etc.), students must first notify their local representative and host family of their desire to do so, thereby giving adequate advance (i.e., 6 – 8 weeks) notice to begin this process. In addition the student must meet the following requirements:

### **The Student Must Be In Good Standing:**

**1). Program:**

Student has met all program requirements

Student must not have any written warnings, probation letters, or other disciplinary issues

**2). Host Family:**

Student is an active host family participant (i.e., engaging in conversation, activities, and chores)

Student must follow all reasonable host family rules and/or requests

**3). School:**

Student must maintain at least a C in every class

Student must not have any disciplinary concerns or disciplinary actions taken by the school

### **Additional Prerequisites:**

**1). Age/Grade Level:**

Student must be listed as 'senior' in their placement status at their high school

**2). Financial:**

Student is responsible for all costs associated with the exam/s

**3). Travel to and from test site:**

Student is responsible for notifying host family of date, time, and location of test. Students must not expect the host family to provide transport, unless the host family is in agreement and able to do so

In addition, student must notify the host family in advance (i.e., 6 – 8 weeks) of pursuing testing, so as to not inconvenience the host family

If the host family is not able to assist, the student is responsible for arranging their own transportation to the test site. All travel must meet Nacel Open Door travel requirements

**4). Program/school/host family:**

Testing must not interfere with the student's program requirements, school obligations, or host family plans

**Any student not meeting these requirements will not be allowed to take part in testing. Nacel reserves the right to deny any student's request for taking an entrance exam and will make the final decision based on conversations with the student, local representative, and host family.**

**Should the student persist or should the student's actions cause disruption to the student's program, school obligations, or hosting experience, arrangements will be made to terminate the student's program pending flight arrangements to home country.**
