


Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

Philadelphia is a historic and lively East Coast city filled with cultural landmarks, parks, and attractions. Students might explore popular sites such as the Philadelphia Zoo, Longwood Gardens, and Valley Forge National Park, or enjoy local favorites like Linvilla Orchards, King of Prussia Mall, Hersheypark, and Citizens Bank Park. Excursions to the New Jersey shoreline or New York City are also possible.





New England Area

The New England region offers a unique mix of historic cities, coastal destinations, and scenic outdoor areas. Students might visit popular sites such as Boston Common, Faneuil Hall, and Quincy Market, or attend summer events like WaterFire and the Newport Kite Festival. They may also tour the Newport Mansions, visit Roger Williams Park Zoo, take a ferry to Block Island, or attend a baseball or soccer game. Students fly into Boston and may be placed with host families in Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island, or New Hampshire.





Salt Lake City, Utah

Surrounded by mountains, open space, and the largest salt water lake in the Western Hemisphere, Salt Lake City offers students a chance to experience living in one of the country's most scenic regions. Students can visit the Hogle Zoo, the Loveland Living Planet Aquarium, and local museums, or tour historic Temple Square. They may also spend time hiking in the nearby mountains, swimming in local lakes, camping, or shopping in the area's many stores and malls.
